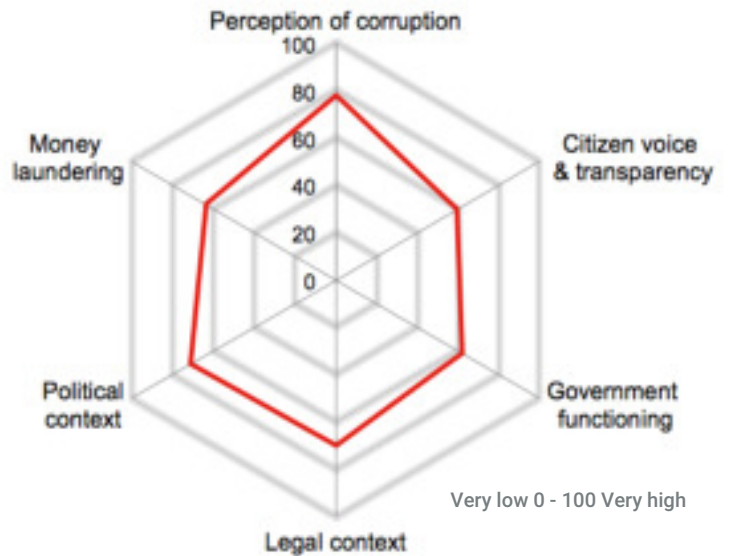

Pakistan presents relatively high scores in all indicators of the Global Corruption Index 2019.

Key facts

? Perception of corruption: according to the Rule of Law Index 2020, Pakistan is one of the most corrupt countries (ranked 116 out of 128 for Absence of Corruption) and shows a concerning decreasing trend for the past 5 years.

? Experience of corruption: The 2017 Global Corruption Barometer reports that up to 25% of Pakistani residents had to pay a bribe to access a public service.

? Global Peace: Pakistan figures among the 5 least peaceful countries in the world with regards to ongoing conflicts. The county notably has the worst worldwide score for internal conflicts fought. (Source: Global Peace Index 2019)

? Discrimination: the country ranks 158 out of 178 for Factionalized Elites, which measures the fragmentation of state institutions along ethnic, class, clan, racial or religious lines etc.

Pakistan also faces strong divisions based on social or political characteristics.
