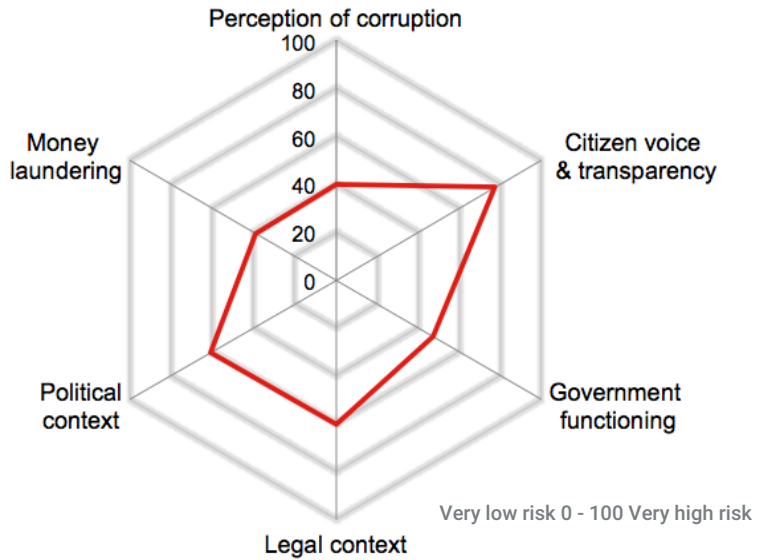

Key facts

? Despite a seemingly good performance from a corruption perception perspective (rank 30 / 180 on Transparency International's 2019 CPI), the Global Corruption Index raises important red flags for Qatar, deriving from a heavily centralized and opaque government.

Opacity creates corruption opportunities by facilitating arbitrary allocation of resources and reducing detection risks for corrupt officials. In Qatar, only scant budget information is given to the general public (*Open Budget Index 2017*), ranking Qatar as low as 165 in Citizen voice & transparency.

Key facts

? Environment: Ranked 32 out of 180 countries on the 2018 Environmental Performance Index, Qatar figures close to best performers.

? Civil & political rights: this measure captures one of Qatar's major issues, i.e. political rights & civil liberties. As of 2019, Qatar is rated as a "not free" country by Freedom House.

? Labour rights: Qatar is ranked among the worst countries for workers. Labour rights are considered not guaranteed (*ITUC Global Rights Index 2018*).

? Health: Qatar has an overall good medical care system, ranked 35 out of 184 countries.
