BY GRP

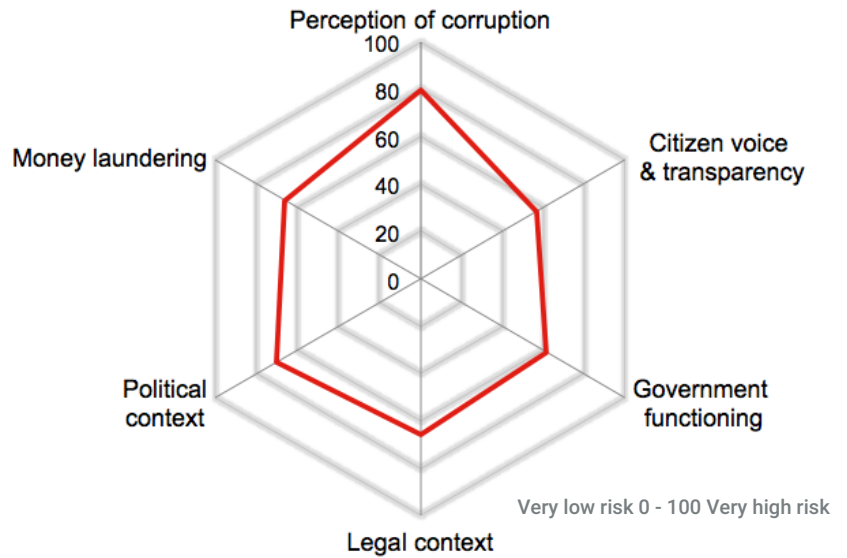

Key facts

- Nigeria ranks 166 out of 198 countries in perception based measures of corruption, standing among the world's most corrupt countries, between Honduras and Iraq.
- 78% of Nigerian residents are exposed to at least 1 bribe situation a year, and 44% of them actually pay (the) bribe(s), as estimated through survey-based data (*Global Corruption Barometer, Africa results, 2019*).
- Democracy: Nigeria ranks just above countries deemed as under authoritarian rule. (*Democracy Index 2020, The EIU*).

Key facts

- Sanitation and access to drinking water is a major issue in Nigeria: the country has one of the world's most concerning situations along with Niger, the Central African Republic and Chad (*EPI Index 2020*).
- Health: More than 44% of the total population is in moderate or severe food insecurity (*estimate based on a 3 year average 2017-2019 - UN Food and Agriculture Organisation*)
- Child Labour: Up to 31% of children aged 5-17 years are engaged in child labour (*Estimate - 2019 database - Unicef data*)
